I am retiring from being your District Councillor in May. It has been a pleasure to serve you, and in the last 8 years since I was first elected, a lot has changed in Honeybourne & Pebworth – hopefully for the better.

My first aim was to get **Superfast Broadband** into our area, and this has been achieved for the vast majority of residents. Superfast Broadband means download speeds of 24Mbps or faster. This is an incredible difference to the meagre 1 or 2 Mbps most of us were getting 8 years ago. Even an email would take many seconds to download. We all sat at our computer screens watching the whirly sign spin as things downloaded!

One of my other aims was to put **Honeybourne & Pebworth on the map** so the District Council knew us and actively helped our community. Again, I believe this has been achieved, and the District Council has been very supportive.

In fact only this month (March), the District Council has agreed to give a grant of £100,000 to Pebworth village hall to be refurbished and extended, and £150,000 towards the brand new Honeybourne village hall which will be built off Grange Farm Drive.
